**Covid-19 Statement - Super Dudes - Childcare**

Our Childcare provision is operating in line with the schools Covid-19 RA  
 However, I would like to highlight for reassurance some of the changes that are now in operation for everyone's safety.

- Additional PPE available as and when required.
- Increased handwashing by all pupils and staff throughout the session.
- Additional Hand Sanitisers stations available for use for all.
- Children remain in their year group bubbles for childcare.
- 2 metre social distancing rule applies when dropping off and collecting children, floor markings to help identify the space needed between people. Parents/Carers are not able to enter the school building.
- Additional cleaning throughout the session of 'hotspots' such as door handles
- One way system operational in school
- Each bubble will have their own set of play equipment and this will be cleaned frequently.
- The hall will also be used to accommodate childcare to ensure adequate space between childcare bubbles.
- All children will be escorted to their classrooms at 8.45am for the start of the day and remain supervised until their actual start time.
- Children will be allowed to use the toilets when needed and be supervised to prevent overcrowding.
- Should a child develop symptoms of the virus when in childcare the same procedure applies as if it were the school day. Parent/Carer will be contacted and need to be collected immediately as well as being placed in isolation until they can be collected, asked to self-isolate and complete a COVID test. Staff will be wearing the necessary PPE should this happen. 999 will of course be called if they are seriously ill or injured or their life is at risk.
- If a staff member develops symptoms they will be sent home, asked to self-isolate and asked to complete a COVID test. If the results are positive, then guidance will be taken from the NHS Track and Trace team -
- All staff are First Aid Paediatric qualified.
- Staff will try and maintain a level of social distancing where possible
- Additional staffing will be used when required dependent upon childcare numbers.
