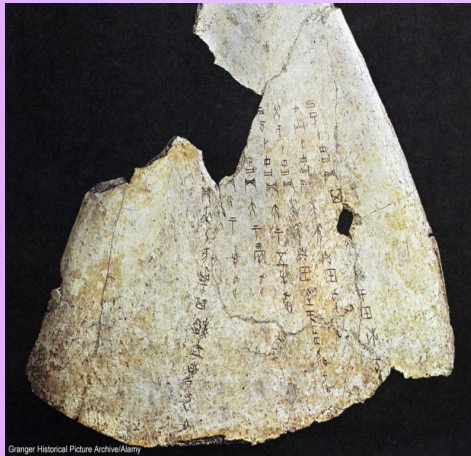


Chinese Mystery – Year 5 – Summer I



Key Names

1	Wang Yirong	Director of the Chinese Imperial Academy, best known as the first to recognize that the symbols inscribed on oracle bones.
2	Hwang Ho	A major river of Asia in northern China.
3	Fu Hao	One of the many wives of King Wu Ding of the Shang dynasty
4	King Cheng Tang	First <i>king</i> of the Shang dynasty in Chinese history.
5	King Di Xin	The last king of the Shang dynasty of ancient China
6	Wu Ding	A king of the Shang dynasty in ancient China, whose reign lasted from approximately 1250-1192 BC.

1	Chinese New Year	The Chinese festival marking the start of the new year .
2	Hieroglyph	A secret or incomprehensible symbol.
3	Prosperity	The state of being prosperous.
4	Typhoon	A tropical storm in the region of the Indian or western Pacific oceans.
5	Emperor	A sovereign ruler of an empire.
6	Shang Dynasty	A Chinese dynasty that ruled in the middle and lower Yellow River valley in the second millennium BC.
7	Excavated	Removal of earth carefully from (an area) in order to find buried remains.
8	Yellow River	The second-longest river in China.
9	Govern	Conduct the policy, actions, and affairs of (a state, organization, or people) with authority.
10	Shangdi	The greatest ancestor and deity who controlled victory in battle, harvest, the fate of the capital, and the weather.
11	Diviner	Like God or a god.
