



End of Year Data Outcomes July 2017

EYFS

There were 60 pupils: 36 boys, 24 girls, 8 SEND, c

The GLD was 60% therefore below the national of 71%. Although in all areas there has been a n increase in the percentage attaining expected from the previous year.

Year 1 Phonics

There were 62 pupils: 31 boys, 31 girls, 9 SEND, 25 Pupil Premium, 15 EAL. 28 pupils have an attendance of 95%+

The school is below National in the percentage of children achieving the standardised score in phonics: 72% v 81%. The previous year 70% achieved the standardised score. Girls are outperforming boys 79% v 65%. There has been an increase in the percentage of PP achieving AS from 50% to 68%.

Year 2 consists of the 18 pupils- 76% achieved the standardised score. Of those children that did not pass, there were 2 EAL and 3 SEND. The previous year 58% achieved AS

When comparing prior data, there was only 1 pupil who attained expected at the end of EYFS in reading who did not achieve AS in phonics, this was due to



the fact that the child is SEND, due to speech and language. There were 6 pupils who did achieve expected in reading at the end of EYFS who did achieve AS in phonics, demonstrating GOOD progress.

End of KS1

There were 60 pupils: 31 boys, 29 girls, 5 SEND, 14 Pupil Premium, 15 EAL and 18 new starters this academic year.
