In RE we will be learning about:

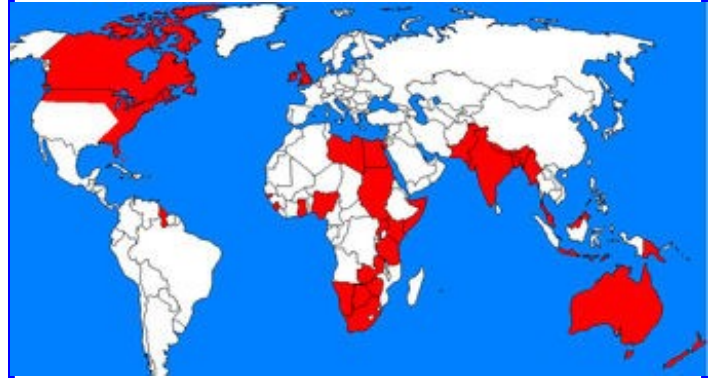
- Sikhism.
