Tudor
Tudor houses are often uneven with big roofs. The walls are made of wooden beams filled with plaster. They have small windows with little panes of glass.

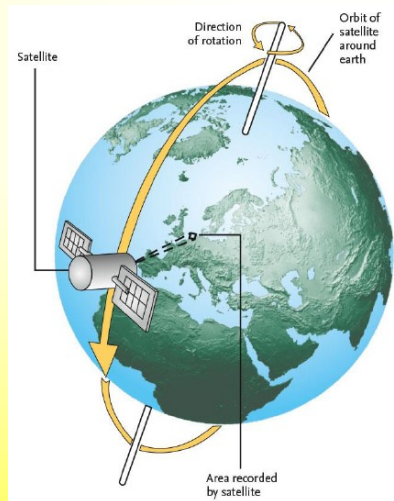
Georgian
Georgian houses have brick walls and tall elegant windows. Sometimes there are pillars round the front door. The roof is hard to see.

Victorian terrace
In Victorian times terraces or rows of houses were put up for workers. The houses were small, all looked alike and had long, thin gardens.

1930s semi-detached
This pair of houses was put up in the 1930s. The windows are square and the walls are covered in concrete. The roofs are made of slate.

1960s semi-detached
The houses that were put up in the 1960s had very large windows. The walls were mostly made of brick and the roofs were tiled.

2000 modern style
The houses in this courtyard use a mixture of building materials and shapes. They are sometimes linked together by garages.
