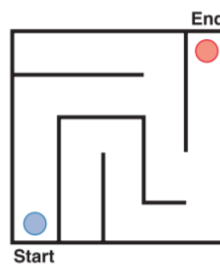
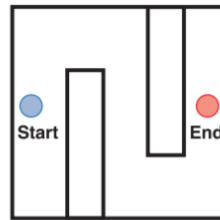


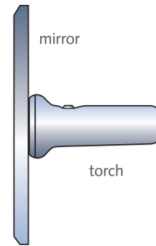
Can you see me? — Year 3 — Autumn 2

Vocabulary

1	Shadow	A dark area or shape produced by a body coming between rays of light and a
2	Reflect	Throw back (heat, light, or sound) without absorbing it.
3	Mirror	A surface, typically of glass coated with a metal amalgam, which reflects a clear
4	Bright	Giving out or reflecting much light; shining.
5	Dim	Not shining brightly or clearly.
6	Beam	A ray or shaft of light.
7	Ultraviolet	Having a wavelength shorter than that of the violet end of the visible spectrum
8	Luminous	Giving off light; bright or shining.
9	Infrared	Having a wavelength just greater than that of the red end of the visible light spectrum but less than that of micro-
10	Ray	Each of the lines in which light (and heat) may seem to stream from the sun
