This is an exciting new topic for year 1 this year and we look forward to exploring where we live further.

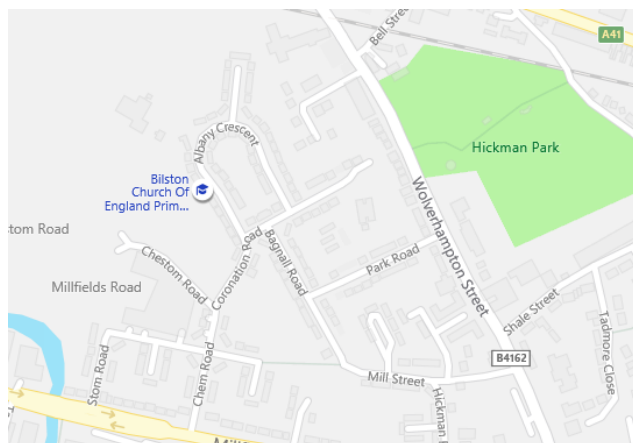


Over the next half term, we will be taking part in a whole school R.E day, harvest festival as well as a Macmillan coffee morning.
